DAY 1 - SATURDAY, November 14, 2026: Arrive in Lima, Peru

Journey by private transfer to the InterContinental Real Lima Milaflores. Tonight, savor the culinary art of chef Jaime Pesaque at SAPIENS to begin your Peru luxury tour.
