Their names remain on a cave wall today. Because the beauty of Fantastic Caverns is vulnerable, the cave is toured in Jeep-drawn trams. This afternoon enjoy lunch at Lambert's Café 'Home of the Throwed Rolls'. Following lunch we will depart for St. Louis, MO to check into the hotel and enjoy the complimentary kickback reception. The remainder of the evening will be on your own. Hotel: *Drury Plaza*, St. Louis, MO. (Breakfast, Lunch)

### Sunday, September 12: Gateway Arch Museum & Tram Ride to the Top, Depart for Ohio
