ITINERARY

Sunday, July 11: Thousand Islands Winery

7:00AM Motorcoach will depart Lancaster, AC Moore store at the Lancaster Shopping Center on the Oregon Pike/Route 272 side of the store.

8:00AM Motorcoach will depart Harrisburg, AAA Central Penn office, 2301 Paxton Church Rd; travel to Alexandria Bay, NY with appropriate rest and meal stops en route.

Welcome to the Thousand Islands! It's here that Ontario and the United States meet... their cultures blending in the waters of the mighty St. Lawrence and Great Lake Ontario. Natives called this region the "Garden of the Great Spirit." Today, many people still remark that this gorgeous garden of woods and water, that is the 1000 Islands, is truly one of the most beautiful places on the planet. This afternoon, enjoy a tour and tasting at the Thousand Islands Winery.

Experience the charming atmosphere of the Winery, housed in the original 1923 Sears & Roebuck barn while the friendly & knowledgeable staff reveals information on their award winning wines and the history of the property. Check into the hotel with time to freshen up before a delightful dinner this evening. Hotel: *Riveredge Resort*, Alexandria Bay, NY (Dinner)

Monday, July 12: Singer Castle and Boldt Castle

Following breakfast, we'll board a boat for a Two-Nation tour through the Thousand Islands. The cruise offers both historical commentary and beautiful scenery from both the American and the Canadian sides of the Islands. Hear the colorful history of the magnificent gilded age homes and landmarks such as Sunken Rock Lighthouse and Devils Oven. Travel through channels where it seems you could almost reach out and touch the Islands. Included is a visit to the mysterious Singer Castle on Dark Island.

Singer Castle was built at the turn of the century by Commodore Bourne, President of the Singer Sewing Machine Company, as a hunting lodge. It remained in his family for half a century until it was bought by Reverend Martin in the 60's and he established the castle as a religious retreat.

Take a short ferry ride to Heart Island for a visit to Boldt Castle. Built by George Boldt, the castle was the ultimate gift of love for his darling wife Louise. When construction of Boldt Castle was well underway, tragedy struck. In January 1904, George sent his workers a telegram saying, "Stop all work, Louise has died." Heartbroken, he never returned to Heart Island again. This afternoon, return to the resort to enjoy the remainder of the day and evening at your leisure, explore the town and have dinner at one of the great waterfront restaurants.(Breakfast)

Tuesday, July 13: Historic Villages of Sackets Harbor and Clayton & Dinner Cruise

After breakfast depart for historic Sackets Harbor, located along the Lake Ontario shore. Sackets Harbor played an integral role in the War of 1812 when this protected port provided the US Navy safe harbor to work from, as well as a protected ship building port from which they procured supplies. Meet our local guide for a tour of the village with views of Pickering Beach Museum, Madison Barracks, Military Cemetery, Market Park Square and much more! Visit Sackets Harbor Battlefield where costumed interpreters at the Battlefield and Commandants House bring to life the passion of the battles!

After the tour, you'll have independent time for lunch on your own in this charming waterfront town before continuing on to historic Clayton, once known as a prime boat building port. Enjoy a visit to the Antique Boat Museum, North America's premier freshwater nautical museum, and home to the longest running antique boat show. Return to the resort to freshen up before a two and a half hour dinner cruise. Enjoy being wined, dined and entertained as you cruise through some of the most romantic channels in the 1000 Islands. (Breakfast, Dinner Cruise)

Wednesday, July 14: Depart for Central Pennsylvania

This morning enjoy breakfast and some free time in Alexandria Bay to explore the village at your leisure.
