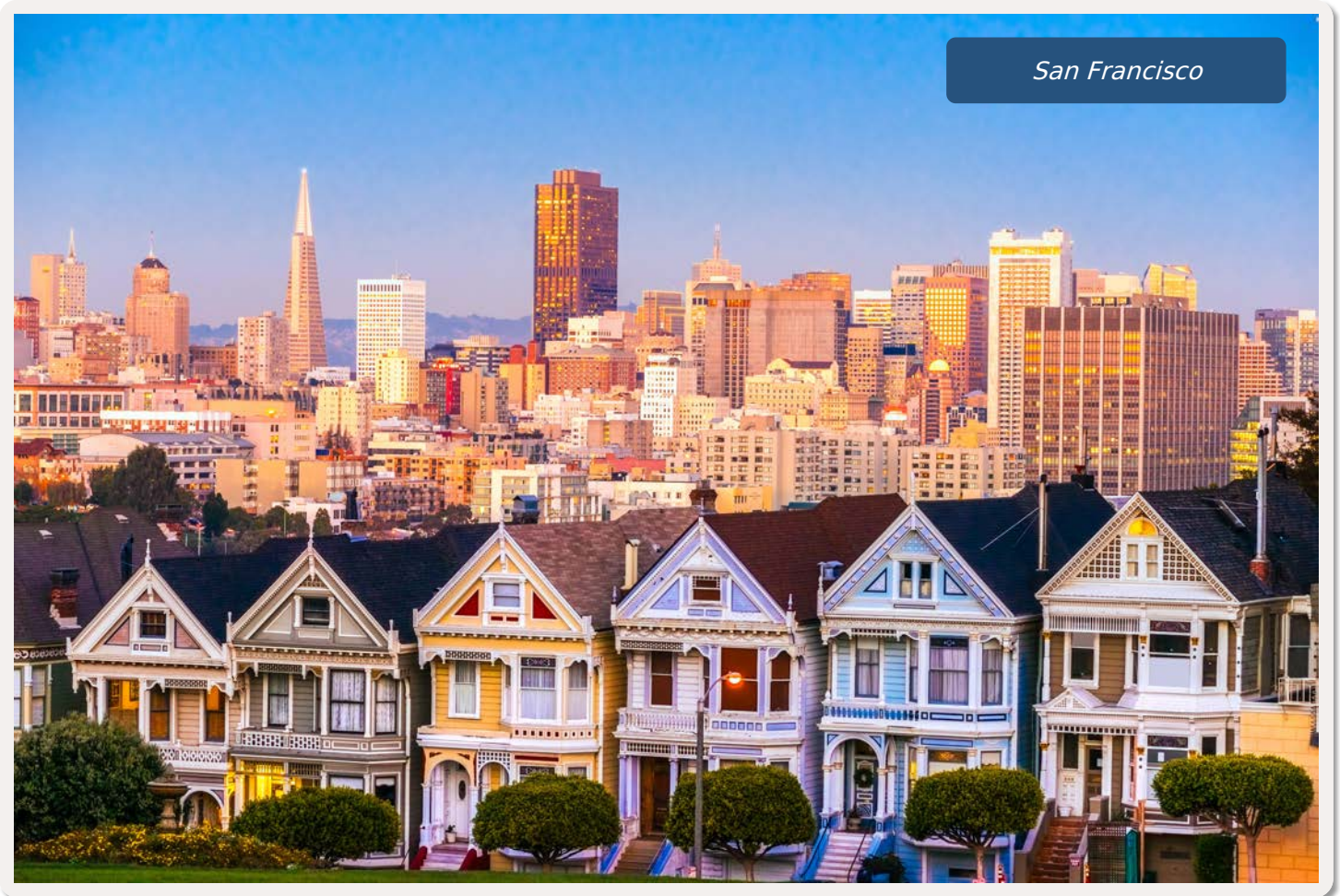

## HIGHLIGHTS

### Catalina Island

Just off the coast of Southern California, lovely Catalina Island offers endless adventures on both land and sea. Snorkel the clear waters or venture out on a glass-bottom boat tour to view the colorful marine life and sunken shipwrecks. Equally scenic vistas await you on a hiking, biking or zip-lining excursion through the island's grasslands and woodlands. Be sure to take a behind-the-scenes tour of the Catalina Casino. Perched along the harbor, this spectacular entertainment venue has been the center of the island's cultural scene since it opened in 1929.

### Ensenada, Mexico

Located on the west coast of Baja California, Ensenada is a sportsman's paradise with popular pursuits including surfing, sport fishing, sea kayaking, horseback riding and mountain biking. If you prefer more leisurely activities, take a scenic coastal drive to the Punta Banda Peninsula to see La Bufadora. This marine geyser that shoots from the sea toward the clifftops is one of the largest blowholes in North America. Back in town, pop into famous Hussong's Cantina and sip a margarita in the bar where the cocktail was reputedly invented.

### San Diego

This is living proof that a big city can still feel like a small town. Its Spanish heritage is evident at popular sights like the Junípero Serra Museum, where the first mission was founded, and at Point Loma, which is dominated by a statue of explorer Juan Rodríguez Cabrillo. The breathtaking point is also a great spot to watch for migrating Pacific gray whales. Other noteworthy attractions include the thought-provoking San Diego Museum of Man, the peaceful Botanical Building and Lily Pond, and the signature San Diego Zoo, where rare species such as giant pandas and lowland gorillas are exhibited. Ship buffs will enjoy the maritime museum, where you can board and tour the vessels.

### San Francisco

With icons like the orange-colored Golden Gate Bridge, clanging streetcars, rolling fog and impossibly steep hills, scenic San Francisco never fails to capture your heart. While the setting is dramatic, the atmosphere is positively laissez-faire, so feel free to do whatever you wish. Tour notorious Alcatraz. See predators like the sharks that live in the surrounding waters at the Aquarium of the Bay. Observe the bonsai in the Japanese Tea Garden in emerald-green Golden Gate Park. Go up mural-covered Coit Tower atop Telegraph Hill for an amazing view of the city, which looks even more dynamic at night.

## Monterey

The rugged cliffs, lush cypress and cerulean waters of the Monterey Peninsula are so stunningly beautiful that one of the area's most famous attractions is simply a 17-mile drive along the coast. Perched on these scenic shores, the town of Monterey has long inspired artists and authors alike. Recalling the city's heyday as a sardine canning capital, Ocean View Boulevard was renamed Cannery Row after John Steinbeck's novel by that name immortalized the street. Now the fishing shacks along the waterfront have been quaintly refurbished into antique shops and restaurants, and one former cannery houses a world-renowned aquarium. You could spend all day picking the best clam chowder on Fisherman's Wharf, but you should also have a salad. The cold waters of the offshore Blue Grand Canyon, twice the depth of its namesake, create a uniquely temperate climate that harvests the freshest produce in the country, as well as distinctive wines.

## Santa Barbara

Known as The American Riviera, the enchanting town of Santa Barbara is nestled between the picturesque coastline of its southern shores and the verdant Santa Ynez Mountains rising steeply to the north. The warm sunshine of a Mediterranean climate illuminates the red-tiled roofs and adobe façades of the town's Spanish Colonial architecture, including the grand Old Mission founded by the first Spanish settlers in the 18th century. Santa Barbara may be best enjoyed with a pleasant stroll, be it through Shoreline Park, along Stearns Wharf or down hip State Street. Renowned art and history museums, wine-tasting rooms, seaside cafés and charming boutiques provide endless entertainment in town, while just over the mountains in the fertile Santa Ynez Valley, you can tour several award-winning wineries.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Travel Documents

U.S. citizens on homeport cruises (cruises that begin and end at the same U.S. port) are currently able to enter or depart the country with a state issued birth certificate with a raised seal and government issued photo ID. AAA recommends traveling with an original, signed passport valid for 6 months beyond stay, and with at least one blank visa page for visa stamps(s). A government issued photo ID that is REAL ID compliant will be required for airport security.

### Payment

Deposit of \$750 per person/\$1500 per cabin will confirm your reservation. Final payment is due to AAA by **May 28, 2021**.

### Clothing/Climate

Average temperatures for California in September are in the 80s. Daytime, casual clothes and comfortable walking shoes are recommended. For evening dining, elegant casual resort wear is suggested.

## **Flight**
